 cleaning. If this is not adequately responded to, a second, and more imperative,
 letter follows. If another warning is needed, it will be sent by the board stating that
 cleaning will be done by an external party at the resident/owner's expense. We
 continue to insist on this because there are still residents who are not careful with
 their living environment.
- When moving into a new home, there can be a lot of rebuilding. Think about the times and days when work is allowed. Especially with loud noises, you should adhere to the guidelines. In addition, you are responsible for cleaning the lifts, portals and corridors.
