

- Unfortunately, it is still necessary to draw your attention to the following: Cleaning
 the gallery, both the ceiling and floor, and the window frames is the responsibility of
 the resident/owner. If this is not done adequately, the CC will send a letter
 requesting cleaning. If this is not responded to adequately, a second, and more
 imperative, letter follows. If a further warning is needed, it is sent by the board with
 the announcement that cleaning will be carried out by an external party at the
 resident/owner's expense.
- When moving into a new home, renovating may be required. If you are renovating your property, please be aware that after 7 p.m. and on Sundays and public holidays, you are cautioned to refrain from causing noise pollution out of respect for other local residents. You are also responsible for clearing and cleaning the lifts, portals and corridors. Large and bulky waste will be collected on Wednesdays. On Tuesdays, after 9 p.m., you can put it outside in the designated area. Please put other waste IN the bins.
- Guus de Reus is our caretaker and has the authority to speak to residents about (compliance with) the house rules. His instructions and comments should be taken seriously and followed.
- Scooters, (carrier) bikes and other vehicles are not allowed in public areas. This
 causes nuisance to other residents and is a hindrance in case of emergencies. If we
 find that vehicles are parked in public spaces, they will be parked outside.
